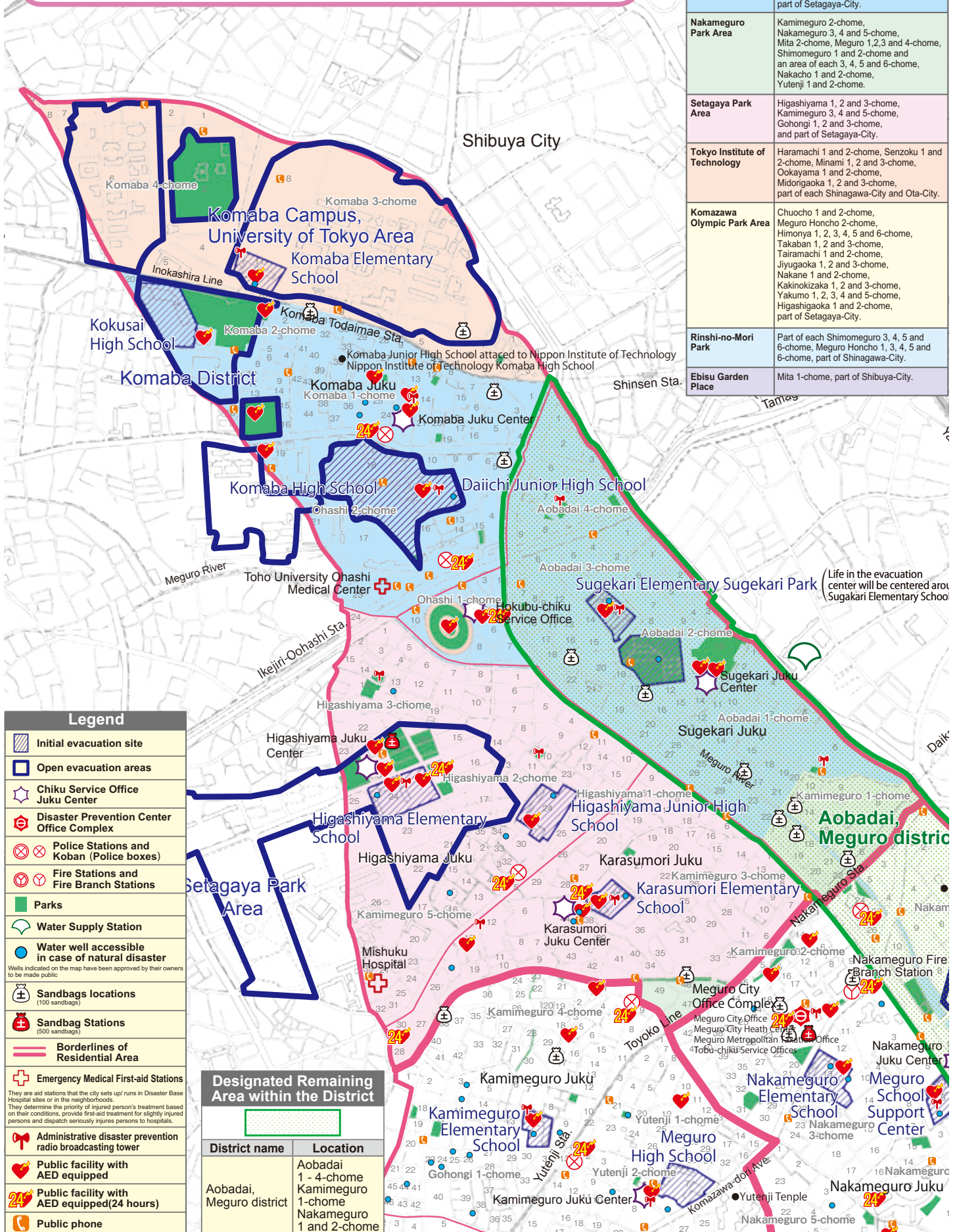


Meguro City Disaster Map (North District)

Tokyo Institute of Technology	Haramachi 1 and 2-chome, Senzoku 1 and 2-chome, Minami 1, 2 and 3-chome, Ookayama 1 and 2-chome, Midorigaoka 1, 2 and 3-chome, part of each Shinagawa-City and Ota-City.
