



Objectives of the Landslide Hazard Map

The Landslide Hazard Map was compiled to help residents to take the appropriate action-including evacuation-in the event of a projected landslide emergency caused by such weather conditions as typhoons, torrential rains, and changes in the ground due to earthquakes.


In May 2018, based on the Sediment Disaster Prevention Act, the Tokyo Metropolitan designated 25 sites in Meguro City as areas to which landslide disaster advisories would apply, amongst which 18 will be open for areas to which special landslide disaster advisories would apply.

The Map indicates areas to which landslide disaster advisories would apply, evacuation sites, public institutions, and more. Also noted is how to obtain related information. Talk with your family members as well as people in the community regarding disaster scenarios on a regular basis, using this map to reduce the risk of damage that landslide disasters would cause
