



The 3Rs represent a keyword for reducing waste and effectively utilizing resources. Let's consider the 3Rs in our daily business activities and see what we can do.





# Outsourcing to a waste disposal company

#### Step 1

Confirm whether the waste from business activities is general business waste or industrial waste.

Contract with respective licensed waste disposal companies when outsourcing waste disposal. (Make sure the contractor is a licensed contractor by presenting a permit or having a copy attached to the contract.)

### General business waste

Food scraps (tea leaves, vegetable scraps, etc.), paper scraps, wood scraps, fiber scraps, and urine and others generated from temporary toilets, etc.



Outsource to a general business waste disposal company licensed by Meguro City

### Industrial waste

Cinder, oil, plastic, rubber, metal, glass, concrete, ceramics, etc.



Outsource to an industrial waste disposal company licensed by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government.

When outsourcing to a general business waste disposal company, please confirm the details of the contract first!

### Point 1


Make sure that the contract clearly lists the type of garbage to be collected, the amount, collection location, collection time, disposal fees, and other details.

### Point 2

General business waste disposal companies are prohibited by law from charging more than the maximum amount of 40 yen/kg (as of April 2023)\* set by the Meguro City ordinance. (If you agree to a flat rate, please check the amount of waste against the processing fee.)

\* Notices The upper limit will be raised to 46 yen/kg from October 2023. Please check the city's PR for details.

Notice to all business entities in the district

**Companies are generally** expected to handle their own recycling and waste disposal!

Businesses are required to comply with the laws and ordinances\* as follows.

- Properly dispose of waste generated in the course of business activities at one's own responsibility
- Endeavor to reduce the amount of
- Cooperation with the ward policies
  - Waste Management and Public Cleansing Law (Enacted on September 24, 1971)
  - \* Meguro City Ordinance Concerning the Control of Waste Generation, Promotion of Reuse, and Proper Disposal of Waste (Enacted on April 1, 2000)

### What are the responsibilities of waste disposal?

- Outsource to a licensed waste disposal company
- Take the waste to a waste disposal facility such as a waste incineration plant

and other methods. Please dispose of the materials properly at your own expense.

### Under regulations, the district does not collect recyclables and waste generated by businesses.

However, only businesses that generate less than 50 kg of recyclables and waste per day and are unable to dispose of it on their own may place for fee-based municipal collection service to the extent that it does not interfere with the collection of household waste.

## All recyclables and waste require a disposal fee.

To ensure that the burden is appropriate, please be sure the proper prepaid waste disposal stickers are placed before placing the waste out for collection. Waste without a sticker or with a sticker price of which is short of required fee will not be collected.

Recyclables and waste generated by businesses...

This refers to recyclables and waste generated in the course of business activities, whether by a company, restaurant, shop, or any other business. Business activities include not only for-profit activities but also activities such as education and welfare programs and public services. It also includes plastic bottles, food containers, and any other waste generated by employees during mealtime and the like.
